## Thank You

Your Fundraising helps real women and their families living with cancer through pregnancy and beyond.

**£50** parking costs for 8/10 visits to hospital.

**£35** An hours private counselling for mum (so that she's not waiting months for an appointment)

**£80** Mastectomy swimwear so mum has the confidence to do 'normal' activities with her family again.

**£100** Travel/mileage costs from appointments for 3 months.

**£200** An adapted swivel car seat which makes it easier for mum to get baby in and out of the car after surgery.

**£250** An iPad which can be loaned to families to have face time when mum is in hospital overnight, so she can still 'be there' at bed/storytime.

**£400** Pays for 3 months of childcare while Mum is at hospital having her chemo.

**£500** A mini break for a family with terminal diagnosis to create some more lasting memories.
